| Henriendi Reserve | 12 km south & east of Baan Baa | D |
| Harpary Bridge | 13 km east of Baan Baa on Maules Creek Road. | E |
| Tarriaro Reserve | 15 km east of Narrabri on Maules Creek/ Old Gunnedah Road | F |
| Tarriaro Bridge | 14 km east of Narrabri, off Maules Creek Road. | G |
| The Picnic area | Along Maules Creek Road | H |
| Narrabri Creek (in town) | Behind the Narrabri RSL Club and along the creek throughout Town | I |
| Trindall's Reserve | Several tracks lead left off the Wee Waa/Narrabri road just west of Narrabri town boundary and lead to the River. | J |
| Mollee Reserve | Approx 12 km from Narrabri on Wee Waa Rd, turn left and follow the track to river | K |
| Myall Vale Reserve | Immediately past Myall Vale turn off on Wee Waa road, turn Left. | L |
| Wee Waa Tip Reserve | Take Pilliga Road near Namoi Cotton Co-Op and turn off at Wee Waa Garbage Tip. | M |
